## **Winter Paralympics**

The 2018 Winter Paralympics have been taking place since the 9<sup>th</sup> of March and will continue in Pyeongchang, South Korea, until 18<sup>th</sup> March. These are the 12th edition of the Games. Great Britain have five medals in total (one gold and four bronze.)



The Paralympics are made up of 6 sports:

- \*Alpine Skiing
- \*Biathlon
- \*Cross-Country Skiing
- \*Para Ice Hockey
- \*Snowboarding
- \*Wheelchair Curling

The Paralympics are an international multi-sport event for athletes with disabilities governed by the International Paralympic Committee (IPC.)

There are over 570 participants competing and many of them with a life changing disability. At the very beginning, the ceremony was opened by president Moon Jae-In.
